Minutes of the Board of Selectpersons

August 6, 2012 7:00 PM Meeting held at the Embden Town Office

In attendance was: Robert Dunphy, Jerome & John Lynch, Wayne McLaughlin, Elizabeth Pratt, Ann Roosevelt, Alton Stevens, Charles Taylor, Michael Witham, and Bonnie Baker.

- 1 Charles Taylor called the meeting to order at 19:04.
- 2 The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3 Consent Agenda:

 - 5.10.1 M. Witham stated it had been a very busy summer.
 - **5.10.2** He said they had done some work on the West Shore Road at the north end, but there was a section just before that which he hadn't done.
 - 5.10.3 He stated there was still at least 500 yards of recycled hot top in the Solon pit.
 - **5.10.4** He said they had replaced a culvert near Wendell Routon's driveway, and had done ditching from the pillars south.
 - 5.10.5 C. Taylor asked whether he had seeded the ditches. M. Witham replied, "Not yet."
 - **5.10.6** He said they had done some tree trimming on the Slipp Road.
 - **5.10.7** He stated he planned to put some surface gravel where the ditching was done last year on the Hancock Pond Rd.
 - **5.10.8** He stated he would bring in the URIP paperwork, and added that the town's allotment would be decreasing.
