

**WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION
TO CALL MAINE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 74 REFERENDUM

TO: Scott LeHay, a resident of Maine School Administrative District No. 74,
composed of the Towns of Anson, Embden, New Portland, and Solon, State of
Maine.

TO: Bonnie Baker, Town Clerk of Embden: you are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF EMBDEN:

You are hereby notified that a Maine School Administrative District No. 74 referendum election will be held at the Embden Town Office, 809 Embden Pond Road in the Town of Embden at 9:00 A.M. on May 13, 2014 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting (Note: the moderator chosen to preside at the referendum town meeting for budget validation shall also serve as moderator for this referendum town meeting).

Article 2: Do you favor authorizing the board of directors of Maine School Administrative District No. 74 to issue bonds or notes in the name of this District for minor capital projects in an amount not to exceed \$2,065,263 for the purpose of constructing and equipping renovations and improvements to Carrabec High School; and to issue the bonds as "qualified zone academy bonds" that qualify for federal subsidy of most or all of the interest payments on the bonds?

The voting on Article 2 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened immediately after the election of the Moderator following commencement of the meeting at 9:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.
