Article 1A: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.


Article 1: Do you favor approving the Regional School Unit No. 74 budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the latest Regional School Unit budget meeting?

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.


