Application Form for TOWN OF EMBDEN Subdivision Approval

Note to Applicant:

Your application for subdivision approval will not be considered complete until a Final Plat Plan, based on a survey, has been submitted to the Planning Board. You are advised to meet with the Planning Board prior to completing this application form, as it may not be necessary to comply with all of the items shown on the form. Following the submission of a sketch plan of your subdivision, answer all questions on the remainder of this form. The review of your subdivision should consist of 3 steps, as outlined below.

- Submission of a sketch plan. The sketch plan shall consist of a rough outline of the proposed subdivision, and may be a free-hand, pencilled sketch of the parcel, showing the proposed layout of streets, lots, and other features which may be of assistance to the Planning Board in making its determinations. In order for the Planning Board to be more fully informed about the site, the subdivider shall arrange a joint inspection of the site with the Planning Board, or an individual appointed by the Chairman to act as the Board's representative for the inspection. The on-site inspection may be conducted at or shortly after the submission of the sketch plan, but this phase of the application process will not be considered complete until such inspection has been made.
- Submission of a Preliminary Plat Plan. Upon submission of a sketch plan, and following an on-site inspection of the site, the Planning Board will outline, by checking specific items on this application, the specific requirements for preliminary plat submission. Specific requirements will vary according to the size and complexity of the subdivision proposal. In some instances, the Planning Board may waive the requirement for a preliminary plat plan submittal, in which case this application form must be submitted with the final plat plan.
- Submission of a Final Plat Plan. After any apparent deficiencies in the preliminary plat plan have been corrected, a final plat plan must be submitted to the Planning Board. Your application for subdivision approval will not be considered complete until the final Plat plan has been submitted.
